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

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EUBREAST's Goals

Focus on the Patient's Well-being

Researching gentler approaches to breast cancer surgery in order to improve the quality of life of affected women is the objective of EUBREAST. As a non-profit organisation, the network of renowned European breast surgeons is dedicated strictly to the well-being of their patients.

Tens of thousands of women are diagnosed with breast cancer each year in every European country. EUBREAST physicians are convinced that gentler surgery is possible in the meantime for many of these patients. Scientifically committed breast surgeons have developed gentle surgical procedures in recent years in order to minimise restrictions after breast cancer surgery, and to promote a quicker and less stressful return to active daily life.

Fewer Radical Operations Based on Clinical Studies

However, in order to develop innovative approaches to therapy and adopt them into the standard guidelines, meaningful studies concerning their effectiveness and safety have to be conducted. These studies are laborious and expensive. Research which is targeted at reducing the amount of required therapy doesn't readily attract financial support, because its results do not involve any economic profit for the sponsors.

Thus far, studies concerning less radical breast cancer surgery have been supported exclusively at the national level with very little government funding. As a result, it has taken many years to treat an adequate number of patients in order to conduct a statistically correct evaluation of new procedures. In many cases, the required number of cases has not been reached at all.

Furthermore, studies conducted in the individual European countries have repeatedly been in competition with each other and no attempt has been made to coordinate their findings.

And thus the scientifically committed breast cancer surgeons from EUBREAST see an urgent need for action in order to improve European cooperation in the field of breast cancer research by coordinating our activities and combining forces. New findings need to be quickly and reliably examined by means of top-quality clinical studies and implemented in medical practice without delay for the well-being of the patients. EUBREAST is committed to this goal as a transnational network and works towards improving the situation of breast cancer patients as a non-profit organisation.

Financing via Donations and Independent Funds

The costs associated with EUBREAST studies amount to millions of Euros and should be financed by the independent, national funding institutions of the member countries, as well as EU funds. However, EUBREAST depends on donations for developing independent studies, getting access to independent funding and for the coordination of the work conducted by the network.

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
